This indenture, of lease, made and entered into in quadruplicate on this 11th day of Sept. A.D. 1922, by and between Ella Carr, nee Brown and Willie Carr her husband and Rachel Clinton, heirs of Gillis Clinton, deceased, enrolled as a full blood citizen of the Creek Nation, Roll No. 4035 of the first part, and hereinafter designated as lessor, and W. B. Pine and D.M. Smith of Okmulgee, Okla., hereinafter designated as lessor, under and in pursuance of the provisions of the Act of Congress approved May 27, 1908. (Stat. L.P. 312) witnesseth:

1. The lessor, for and in consideration of one dollar, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, and of the royalties, covenants, stipulations and conditions hereinafter contained, and hereby agreed to be paid, observed and performed by the lessee, does
