hereby demise, grant lease and let unto the leasee, for the term of tex years from the date of the approval hereof by the Secretary of the Interior, and as much longer thereafter as oil or gas is found impaying quantities, all the oil deposits and natural gas in or under the following described tractof land, lying and being within the county of Tulsa, and state of Oklahoma, to-wit: The

The northwest quarter (NW1) less Midland Valley Railroad right

of section 26, township 17 range 14 of the Indian Meridian, and containing 160 acres more or less, with the exclusive right to prospect for, extract, pipe, store and remove oil and natural gas, and to cocupy and use so much, only of the surface of said land as may ressonable be necessary to carry on the work of prospecting for, extracting, piping. storing and removing such oil and natural gas, also the right to obtain from wells or other sources on sid land by means of pipe lines or otherwise, a sufficient supply of water to carry on said operations, and also, the right to use, fee of cost, oil and natural gas as fuel so far as necessary to the development and operatinof said property.

- 2. The lessee hereby agrees to pay or cause to be paid to the Superintendent of the Five Civilized Tribes, Muskogee, Oklahoma, for the lessor, as royalty, the sum of 122 per cent of the gross proceeds of all crude oil extracted from the said land, such payO ment to be made at the time of sake or removal of the oil. And the lessee shall pay as royalty on each gas producing well three hundred dollars per annum in advance, to be calculated from the date of commencement of utilization: Provided, however, in the case of gas wells of small volume, when the rock pressure is one hundred points or less, the parties hereto may, subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Interior, agree upon a royalty, which will become effective as a part of this lease; Provided, further, that in case of gas wells of small volume, or where the wells produce both oil and gas or oil and gas and selt water, to such extent tothe gas in unfit for ordinary domestic purposes, or where the gas from any "il is desired for temporary use in connection with drilling and pumping operations on adjacent or nearby tracts, the lessee shall have the option of paying royalties upon such gas wells of the same percentage of the gross proceeds from the sale of gas from such wells, as is paid under this lease for royalty on The lessor shall have the free use of gas for domestic purposes/in his residence on the lessed premises, provided there shall be surplus gas produced on said premises over and above enough to fully operate the same. Failure on the part of the lessee to use a ges producing well, which cannot prfitally be utilized at the mte herein prescribed shall not work a forfeiture of this lesse so far as the same relates to mining oil, but if the lesee desires to retain gas producing privileges, the lessee shall pay a rental of one hundred dollars per annum, in advance, solculated from date of discovery of gas on each gas producing well, gas from which is not marketed or not utilized otherwise than for operations under this lease. Payments of annual gas royalties shall be made within twenty five days from the date such royalties become due, other royalty payments to be made monthly or before the 25th day of the month succeeding that for which such payment is/made, supported by sworn statements.
- 3. Until a producing well is completed on said premises, the lessee shall pay, or cause to ba peid, to said Superintendent for the Five Civilized Tribes, Muskogee, Okler homs, for lessor, as advanced annual royalty, from the date, of the approval of this lease fifteen cents per scre per annum, annually, in advance for the first and second years; thirty cents per scre per shoum, annually, in advance for the third and fourth years; seventybfive cents per ace per annum, annually, inadvance, for the fifth year; and one dollar per ours per sanum, annually, in advance, for each succeding year of the term of
