

WHEREAS, It was provided by said Act of Congress that each member of said tribe shall, at the time of the selection of his allotment, designate, or have selected and designated for him, from his allotment, land equal in value to forty acres of the average allottable lands of the Cherokee Nation, as nearly as may be, as a homestead, for which separate certificate shall issue; and,

WHEREAS, The said Commission to the Five Civilized Tribes has certified that the land hereinafter described has been selected by or on behalf of Arvol V. Thomas, a citizen of said tribe, as a homestead,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, the undersigned, the Principal Chief of the Cherokee Nation, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the aforesaid Act of the Congress of the United States, have granted and conveyed, and by these presents do grant and convey unto the said Arvol V. Thomas all right, title and interest of the Cherokee Nation, and of all other citizens of said Nation, in and to the following described land, viz: The North Half of the North East quarter of the South West Quarter and the South West Quarter of the North East Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section Twenty-four (24), Township Twenty (20) North and Range Twelve (12) East of the Indian Base and Meridian, in Indian Territory, containing thirty (30) acres, more or less, as the case may be, according to the United States survey thereof, subject, however, to the conditions provided by said Act of Congress pertaining to allotted homesteads.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, the Principal Chief of the Cherokee Nation, have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of said Nation to be affixed this 29th day of June A. D., 1905.
