ORDER SETTING APART HOMESTEAD FOR FAMILY.

It appearing to the Court that J. E. McCutchan, the duly qualified and acting administrator of the Estate of Grace S. McCutchan, deceased, having this day made application to this Court, by petition for an order setting apart for the use of the family of the said deceased, a certain quantity of land hereinafter particularly described, together with the dwelling house and other improvements thereon, which were occupied by said deceased and her family at and prior to the time of her death, as a homestead; and that since the time of her death, and up to the present, said family have remained in possession of said homestead, and the Court finds that it is for the best interest of said estate that the said real property should be set apart for the use of said family.
