STIPULATION MODIGYING TERMS OF OIL & GAS MINING LEASE.

Southwest Quarter (SW/4) of the Northwest Quarter (NW/4) of Section Thirtysix (36), Township Eighteen (18) North, Range Twelve (12) East, containing 40 acres, Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

WHEREAS, the present owner of the lease and the owners of said described land desire to amend, change and modify certain terms of said contract.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the owners, and other and further valuable considerations, said lease is hereby modified so that Clause 3 of the original lease is to read as follows;-

"To pay the lessor for gas produced from any oil well and used off of the premises, at the rate of One Eighth (1/8) part of the Market value of said casing-head gas sold by the lessee, said payment to be made monthly."
