I, Latolia Goodman, of lawful age, being first duly sworn depose and say, that I am a resident of the City of Columbus, State of Ohio, that I am more than Twenty-one years of age, my father was Archibald R. Byrkit, and my mother was Martha E. Byrkit, the wife of Archibald R. Byrkit, both of whom were residents of Fairfield, Jefferson County, State of Iowa, that my father Archibald R. Byrkit died about November 9, 1917, in Fairfield, Iowa, that my mother, Mrs. Martha E. Byrkit, the wife of Archibald Byrkit, died at Fairfield, Iowa, in June, 1918, that my father's estate was not probated, nor any proceedings had to determine heirship, that there were only two children, born to Archibald Byrkit, my father and Martha E. Byrkit, wife of Archibald Byrkit, my mother, that each of said children are now living, the affiant herein Latolia Goodman, nee Latolia Byrkit, now living in the City of Columbus, State of Ohio, and Myrta B. Dixon nee Byrkit, now living in Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma; that there are no other heirs of Archibald Byrkit or Martha B. Byrkit, living or dead; that there are no other children, living or dead, save and except the two herein named; or any issue of any heir or heirs, or any child or children, now deceased of the said Archibald Byrkit and the said Martha E. Byrkit, his wife; that the said Archibald R. Byrkit and the said Martha E. Byrkit, or either of them ever contracted any other marriage, except as herein named; that on or about July 2, 1915, John Kosher and Edith A. Kosher, his wife, made and executed one certain mortgage, to Archibald R. Byrkit of Jefferson County, Iowa, in the amount of One Thousand Dollars, payable in installments of \$20.00 each, monthly, interest at the rate of eight per cent per annum, said mortgage being filed of record, July 3, 1915, at 8:45 A. M., in the office of the Register of Deeds, within and for Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, recorded in Book 124, page 591, that said mortgage has been fully paid and satisfied, as shown by one certain release of mortgage, made by Myrta B. Dixon and Latolia Goodman, to John Kosher and Edith A. Kosher, dated Mar. 23, 1920, and filed of record May 19, 1920, at 8:00 A.M. in the office of the County Clerk within and for Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, in Book 348, page 203, that the money therefor was paid in full by said mortgagors, and received by said mortgagee and the heirs of said mortgagee, and that the said Myrta B. Dixon, nee Byrkit, and the said Latolia Goodman, nee Byrkit, being the sole and only heirs of the said Archibald R.
