ASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS LEASE

WHEREAS, On the 27th day of April 1914, a certain oil and gas mining lease was made and entered into by and between Fred M. Bussey Lessor and The Coffeyville Vitrified Brick & Tile Company Lessee covering the following described land in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma to-wit:

The Alke Drilling Company in as far as it covers all oil rights, and the gas rights below the fourteen hundred foot (1400) depth from the surface, provided the Coffeyville Vitrified Brick & Tile Company have the option to purchase all gas produced below this level at ten cents (10c) per thousand cubic feet, based on one pound pressure per square inch, delivered at the well, and it is also provided that in case gas is found in merchantable quantities above the fourteen hundred foot (1400) level, the Coffeyville Vitrified Brick & Tile Company are to have the option of taking over said gas well and topay the actual expense of drilling said well to that depth.

NOW THEREFORE, For and in consideration of One Dollar ( and other good and valuable considerations), the receipt which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned, the present owners of the said lease and all rights thereunder or incident thereto, do they hereby bargain, sell, transfer, assign and convey unto Margay Oil Corporation all of their right, title and interest of the original lessee and present owners in and to said lease and rights thereunder insofar as it covers the above described lands together with all personal property used or obtained in connection therewith to Margay Oil Corporation and their heirs successors and assigns.
