NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of One Dollar ( and other good and valuable considerations), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged the undersigned, the present owner of the said leases and all rights thereunder or incident thereto, does hereby bargain, sell, transfer, assign and convey unto Black, Sivals & Bryson, said undivided one-sixth interest of all the right, title and interest of the original lessee and present owner in and to said leases and rights thereunder in so far as same cover the tract of land last herein above described, together with all personal property used or obtained in connection therewith to Black, Sivals & Bryson, Inc., and its successors and assigns.

And for the same consideration, the undersigned for himself and his heirs, successors and representatives, does covenant with the said assignee his heirs, successors or assigns that he is the lawful owner of the said leases and rights and interests thereunder and of the personal property thereon or used in connection therewith; and that the undersigned has good right and authority to sell and convey the same.
