WITNESSETH; That for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) cash in hand paid unto said party of the first part by the party of the second part, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and confessed, the party of the first part does by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Edna Wrightsman, party of the second part, and unto her heirs, successors and assigns, forever; all of his right, title and interest in and to an undivided three sixty-fourths (3/64) interest in and to all of the oil and gas in and under the south Half (S $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), and the South Half (S $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 10, Township 17 North, Range 12 East, of the Indian Meridian in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, containing one hundred (100) acres more or less.
