

And WE further agree, in case of default in payment of said sums of money, or any part thereof, monthly as aforesaid, to pay all fines and penalties assessed on account thereof, in accordance with the rules, regulations and By-Laws of said Association, and if, in case of default, the stock pledged and the security given to secure said monthly payments shall, upon the sale thereof, be insufficient to prepay said Association any balance which may

be due and owing on said loan. WE promise and agree to fully pay and discharge same. If WE shall fail for a period of six successive months to pay dues, interest or other charges required by the By-Laws or shall become indebted to the Association in a sum equal to the gross amount of dues and interest for a period of six months, then the whole of this obligation shall become due and payable and may be collected by

by said party of the second part shall be applied on the payment of said debt. And the said part 188 of the first part, for said consideration, do hereby expressly waive an appraisalment of said real estate and all the benefits of the homestead exemption and stay laws of the State of Oklahoma.

In the event of legal proceedings to foreclose this mortgage, the indebtedness thereby secured shall bear interest from date of default at the rate of ten (10%) per cent per annum in lieu of further monthly installments, and the shares of stock above referred to shall be cancelled and the surrender value thereof as provided in the By-Laws of said Association, as of the date of the first default, shall be applied in reduction of the sums due on this mortgage.

In the event of default on the part of the mortgagor in the performance of any of the obligations of the said note or of this mortgage, the mortgagee shall be entitled to possession of the premises and to all of the rents and profits thereafter accruing from said property, and shall be entitled to collect and receive the said rents, which less the cost of collection thereof, shall be applied upon the indebtedness hereby secured.
