WITNESSETH, That said part 1st of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said part 1st of the second part their heirs

and assigns, all the following described real estate situated in Tulsa County and State of

Said first part 1st hereby covenant that they are the owners in fee

simple of said premises and that they are free and clear of all incumbrances.

That they have good right and authority to convey and encumber the same and

the V. will warrant and defend the same against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever. Said first part 1st agree to insure the buildings on said

premises in the sum of \$ for the benefit of the mortgagee and maintain such insurance during the existence of this mortgage. Said first part 1st

agree to pay all taxes and assessments lawfully assessed on said premises before delinquent.

Said first part 1st further expressly agree that in case of foreclosure of this mortgage and as often as any proceeding shall be taken to foreclose same

as herein provided, the mortgagor will pay to the said mortgagee twenty five dollars and 10% of amount due as Dollars

as attorney's or solicitor's fees therefor, in addition to all other statutory fees; said fee to be due and payable upon the filing of the petition for foreclosure and the same

said premises, or any part thereof, are not paid before delinquent then the mortgage may effect such insurance or pay such taxes and assessments and shall

be allowed interest thereon at the rate of eight per cent per annum, until paid, and this mortgage shall stand as security for all such payments; and if said

sum or sums of money or any part thereof is not paid when due, or if such insurance is not effected and maintained or any taxes or assessments are not paid before

delinquent, the holder of said note S and this mortgage may elect to declare the whole sum or sums and interest thereon due and payable at once and proceed to

collect said debt including attorney's fees, and to foreclose this mortgage, and shall become entitled to possession of said premises.

Said first part 1st waive notice of election to declare the whole debt above and also the benefit to stay, valuation or appraisal laws.
