And Whereas it is no longer convenient for the said S. P. Odell to act as Trustee. or attorney for said parties in leasing, contracting, managing and controlling said land, and he desires to be releived of his responsibilities as Trustee and as attorney for the owners of said land, and to transfer and convey to the present owners of the said land the legal title thereto now held in trust for them:-

THEREFORE KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS; That I, S. P. Odell of Denton County, Texas in consideration of the premises and the sum of One Dollar to me paid the receipt of which is hereby fully acknowledged, do by these presents resign as trustee and as attorney. as aforesaid, and do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey to the present owners of the beneficial interest in said land, in the proportions set after their respective names, namely., Zilpha E. Kimbrough a feme sole, twenty-sixtieths (20/60), M. E. Davenport, a feme sole ten- sixtieths (10/60), W. C. Kimbrough Six- Sixtieths (6/60), W. L. Foster Six- Sixtieths (6/60), B. R. Parks Five- Sixtieths (5/60), James M. Gourley Five- Sixtieths (5/60) J. E. Williams Four- sixtieths (4/60) Chas H. Kimbrough Two-sixtieths (2/60), Mrs Willie E. Kimbrough one- sixtieth (1/60) and Mrs, Sarah Gibbs One- Sixtieth (1/60), their heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:-

The Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section Eleven (11), Township Eighteen (18) North, Range Twelve (12) East, it being the purpose of this instrument to convey to the owners of the beneficial interest in said land, the legal title thereto in the same proportion that they the beneficial interest,

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditments and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in anywise appertaining,

It is understood that this instrument shall terminate all responsibility and authority conferred upon me by said deed conveying said property to me as Trustee by said power of attorney from and after this date, but the same shall not in any way affect the oil and gas lease and contract heretofore executed, except that the rentals and royalties and other payments shall be made to the owners of said land and not of me as trustee,
