AGREEMENT. made and entered in to this day the 20th day of Sept, 1922, by and between Marie Steinbushel a widow, Herman Steinbuchel Bertha Gpulaner, Fred Stachman, Elizabeth Wilson and Max Steinbuchel of Wichita, Kansas, being all the heirs at law of Herman Steinbuchel Deceased and J. S. Hoping of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and A. D. Kennedy and H. E. Kennedy of Okmulgee, Oklahoma, hereinagter called lessors and J. T. Mc Couloch oc Okmulgee Oklahoma, Leesses,

WITNESSETH; - that the lessor, for the consideration of One and No/100 Dollars cash in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and of the covenents and agreements hereinafter contained on the part of the lessee to be paid kept and performed, has granted demised leased and let and by these presents does grath, demise, lease and let unto the aid lessee for the sole and only purposes of mining and preating for oil and gas and of laying of pipe lines and of building of tanks powers stations and structures thereon to produce save and take care of said products, all that certain tract of land situated in the County of Tulda State of Oklahoma, described as follows to-wit;
