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CONFIRMATION OF PLAT AND DEDICATION OF ROADWAY.

COMPARED

Know all men by these presents: That the undersigned, Chauncy A. Owen, does hereby ratify and confirm a certain plat known as Owen Place addition to the City of ^{Tulsa,} Oklahoma, certified to by J. Gus Patton, surveyor and filed for record in the Office of the Register of Deeds of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, on the 14th day of June, 1910, at 2:50 P.M. and does hereby dedicate the streets and roadways to the Public as shown upon said plat, and does hereby specifically dedicate and convey to the Public, as and for a public street and roadway, a strip of land thirty (30) feet wide lying adjacent to and immediately west of the lots as shown on said plat, said strip being otherwise described as follows:

Beginning at a point one hundred fifty (150) feet west of the northwest corner of block four (4) of Owen addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof, being one hundred fifty (150) feet west of the northeast corner of the southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of section two (2) township nineteen (19) north, range twelve (12) east, thence south three hundred thirty six and eight-tenths (336.8) to the north line of the M.K. & T. right of way; ^{thence southwesterly along the North line of said right of way to a point} thence north parallel to the west line of said Owen Place addition to a point on the north line of the southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said section two (2) one hundred eighty (180) feet west of the northeast corner of the southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said section two (2) thence east a distance of thirty (30) feet to a point of beginning.
