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MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT.
(In duplicate)

Whereas, A. E. Hall, hereinafter called party of the first part, is owner of certain oil and gas leases of which he wishes to convey an interest to J. W. Saunders, W. E. Hancock and C. O. Buckles, co-partners, hereinafter called parties of the second part, for the purpose of having same drilled and developed.

Now, therefore, in consideration of one (\$1.00) dollar by each paid to the other, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and in further consideration of the mutual promises and covenants hereinafter set out, the respective parties hereto bind themselves as follows:

1. The said A. E. Hall party of the first part, agrees to and does hereby convey an undivided three-fourth (3/4) interest in and to the following described oil and gas leases:

(a) An oil and gas lease dated March 15, 1916, wherein Thomas L. Lane and Nora L. Lane, his wife, are lessors and Albert E. Hall is lessee, covering the following described land located in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, described as follows:

The northeast quarter of the southwest quarter of Sect. 30, Twp 22, N R 14 E, which oil and gas lease is recorded in the office of the Recorder of Deeds in Tulsa County in Book 109 and Page 195.

(b) An oil and gas lease dated 14th of June, 1923, wherein J. H. Sirene and Thelma Sirene, his wife are lessors and Albert E. Hall is lessee covering the following described land located in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, described as follows, to-wit:
