E. F. Dixon, being duly sworn on his oath, deposes and says that he resides at Sand Springs, Oklahoma; that he is an accountant and has been employed by Chas. Page at Sand Springs, Oklahoma, for nine years; that he is well acquainted with Mary Evans, formerly Bird, formerly Martin, formerly Ematha, nee Fuswa, a citizen of the Creek Nation of the full-blood, enrolled on the final approved roll of the Creek Nation, opposite Roll No. 8573; that she resides on a farm west of Sand Springs; that she is the same person as Mary Ematha, nee Fuswa, who on the 25th day of February, 1909, conveyed to Chas. Page by warranty deed, the following described real estate and premises situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The north half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the southwest quarter ( $SW\frac{1}{4}$ ); the northwest quarter ( $NW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the southeast quarter ( $SE\frac{1}{4}$ ) the southeast quarter of northwest quarter ( $NE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section 2, township 19 north, range 11, east, being the allotment of Fus Thlocco, deceased, and containing 160 acres, more or less,
