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## ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS. ASSIGNED.

COMPARED

Know all men by these presents:

That in consideration of the sum of one dollar and other good and valuable considerations to us paid receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Liberty National Bank a national banking corporation, does hereby sell, assign, transfer and convey unto the Security National Bank, a national banking corporation of Tulsa, Oklahoma, its successors and assigns, all of its right, title and interest in and to the rents, hereafter falling due on or from the following described land situated in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:
