ORDER FOR REMOVAL OF RESTRICTIONS FOR SCHOOL PURPOSES
DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR.

Washington, D.C. Nov. 8, 1923.

Roll Number 32227 - Full Blood.

Whereas, Lizzie Swimmer, an allottee of the Cherokee Nation, has made application for the removal of the restrictions from the following described land, to-wit:

Beginning at the northwest corner of section 13,
township twenty two (22) north, range thirteen (13)
east of the Indian Base and Meridian, thence south
208 feet, thence east 417 feet, thence north 208 feet,
thence west on section line 417 feet to place of beginning,
containing 2 acres in Tulsa County.

Now, therefore, I, under the authority vested in me by the Act of Congress approved May 29, 1908 (35 Stat. L. 444) and the regulations prescribed thereunder, hereby remove the restrictions from said above described land, provided that such removal and conveyance thereunder shall not relate to or affect minerals lying on or being within or under the above described land, such removal of restrictions to become effective only and simultaneously with the execution of deed by said allottee to School District No. 34, of Tulsa County, Oklahoma.
