in paragraph 12 hereof) shall have the right at any time after thirty days' notice to the lessee specifying the torms or conditions violated, to declare this leave bull and void, and the lessor shall then be entitled and authorized to take immediate possession of the land.

10. Before this lesse shall be force and offect the lessee shall furnish a bond with responsible surety to the satisfaction of the Secretary of the Interior, and suchfurther bond or bonds as may be required by said Secretary, conditioned for the performance of this lesse, which bond shall be deposited and remain on file in the Indiah Office.

11. Assignment of this lesseer any interest therein may be made with the approval of the Secretary of the Interior, it being adderstood that to secure such approval the proposed assignee need only be qualified to hold such a lesse under the rules and regulations, and furnish a bond with responsible surety to the satisfaction of the Secretary of the Interior conditioned for the faithful performance of the covenants and conditions of this lesse.

12. In event restrictions on alienation shall be removed from the leasthold premises described above, this lease shall be released from the supervision of the Secrebry of the Interior, such release to take effect without further agreement, from the date such restrictions are removed, and thereupon the authority and power delegated to the Secretary of the Interior as herein provided shall cease, and all payments required to be made to said Superintendent for the Five Civilized Tribes, Muskogee, Oklahome, shall thereafter be made to lessor of the then owner of said lands in person or be depoisted to the credit of said lessor or his asigns at the First National Bank of Tulsa, Okla.or such other place as the said lessor or his assigns may from time to time designate in writing, and changes in regulations thereafter made by the Secretary of the Juterior applicable to oil and ges lesses shall not apply to/this lesse.

13. Boch and every clause and covenant in this indenture shall extend towthe heirs, executors, administrators, successors and lawful assigns of the parties hereto.
