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interest at the rate of ten (10) percent per annum.

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FIFTH. Should default be made in the payment of said monthly sums, or of any of said fines, or taxes, or insurance premiums, or any part thereof, when the same are payable as provided in this mortgage and in said note and said by-laws and should the same, or any part thereof, remain unpaid for the period of six (6) months, then the aforesaid principal sum of \$3,500.00 dollars, with all arrearages thereon, and all penalties, taxes and insurance premiums, shall, at the option of said mortgagee or of its successors or assigns, become payable immediately, anything hereinbefore contained to the contrary notwithstanding. In the event of legal proceedings to foreclose this mortgage the indebtedness thereby secured shall bear interest from the filing of such foreclosure proceedings at the rate of ten (10) per cent per amoum in lieu of the further payments of monthly installments.

SIXTH. The said mortgagors shall pay to the said mortgagee or to its successors or assigns, a reasonable attorney's fee in addition to all other legal costs, as often as any legal proceedings are taken to foreclose this mortgage for default in any of its covenants or as often as the said mortgagors or mortgagee may be made defendant in any suit affecting the title ofsaid property, which sum shall be an additional lien on said premises.

SEVENTH.
