(3) A part of Lot Four (4) of the Southeast quarter of Section Ten (10), Township Seventeen (17) North, Range Seven (7), West of the Indian Meridian, as shown on the plat attached to that certain warranty deed to said property dated January 10, 1919, from W. L. Taylor and wife, to Oklahoma Gas and Electric Company, and described more particularly as follows:
