AGREEMENT AND DECLARATION OF TRUST.

OKLAHOMA NORTHERN OIL AND GAS CO. OF OKLAHOMA.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT, WHEREAS, P. J. Furcell, W.H. Botkin and Carol E. Botkin, all of Tulsa, Oklahoma, desire to enter into and conduct the business of buying, selling, exploring, and developing oil and gas properties, and their various adjuncts, as trustees and under this declaration of trust;

NOW THEREFORE, It is specifically agreed by and between the said P. J. Purcell, W. H. Botkin and Carol E. Botkin, as follows:

1. All business conducted under this declaration of trust and all things or other documents executed in pursuance of the object of this trust, shall be as far as practicable, under the name of Oklahoma Northern Oil & Gas Co.

2. The principal place of business of said trust shall be at Tulsa, Oklahoma, and such other place or places as the said trustees hereafter designate.

3. This trust shall continue for a period of twenty (20) years from the 18th day of September, 1923, unless dissolved in the manner hereinafter set forth.

4. The purchasers of the beneficials interests in this trust shall be known as unit holders.
