FARM RENTAL CONTRACT

COMPARED

WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter made by the party of the second part and the party of the first part this day and by these presents do demise and let to the party of the second part, heirs and assigns for Agricultural purposes for the term of Five years from the 20th day of December, 1922, the following described parcels of land:

South East 2 of South East 2 Sec. 18 Township 19 N. Range 12 E.

It is understood and agreed that the party of the second part, shall pay to the party of the first part a rental of \$43.75 per annum during the term of this contract payable as follows:

\$21.88 Jan. 1st 1926 and July 1st. 1926  
\$21.88 Jan. 1st. 1927 and July 1st, 1927
