Whereas, Tecumseh Perryman a citizen of the Creek Nation, was allotted the following described land, to-wit:

Southwest quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty-one (21), Township Nineteen (19) north, Range Twelve (12) east of the Indian Base and Meridian, containing Ten (10) acres, more or less, located in Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

Now, Therefore, I, under the authority vested in me by the Act of Congress approved May 27, 1908, (Public No. 140,) and the regulations prescribed thereunder, hereby remove the restrictions from said described land, such removal of restrictions to become effective only and simultaneously with the execution of the deed by said allottee to the purchaser after said land has been sold in compliance with the directions of the Secretary of the Interior.
