 And especially to C.D. Probert of the City of Oconomowoc in said County, Greeting:  
 KNOW YE, THAT WHEREAS, Eleanor J. Coville , late of the City of Oconomowoc , in the County of Waukesha, State of Wisconsin, lately died testate, and being at the time of her decease an inhabitant of said County, by means whereof the proving and registering her LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT, and granting Letters of Administration of all and singular the goods, chattels, rights, credits and estate whereof she died possessed, and also the auditing, allowing, and finally discharging the account thereof is within the jurisdiction of our County Court of said County:

AND WHEREAS, on the 12th day of June A. D. 1923 at the City of Oconomowoc, in said County, before HON. DAVID W. AGNEW, Judge of said County Court, the Last Will and Testament of the said Eleanor J. Coville was proved, allowed and admitted to probate:
