WARRANTY DEED RECORD No. 476

This Indenture, Made this 16th day of October, A. D. 1923, between

D.C. Powers and Eleanor F. Powers, his wife,

of Tulsa, County, in the State of Oklahoma, party of the first part, and,

Edna B. Brown, party of the second part.

Witnesseth: That in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred Twenty-five & No/100

DOLLARS, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, said parties of the first part do hereby these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot Twenty-four (24) in Block Two (2), Lorraine
Drive Addition, to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma,
according to the recorded plat thereof.

As a part of the consideration herein designated, it is provided that no house other than a dwelling and appurtenances thereto shall be built on said lot which shall cost not less than Twenty-Five Hundred (\$2500.00) Dollars; Except a small building for temporary residence may be built on the rear of said lot. Upon any violation of this restriction, the said property hereinabove described shall revert to the parties of the first part.

To Have And To Hold The Same, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said D. C. Powers and Eleanor F. Powers, for themselves and their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part that at the delivery of these presents that they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance in fee simple, of and in all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear and discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates, judgment taxes and assessments and incumbrances of whatsoever nature and kind, EXCEPT.
