Second: And the purchaser, for himself, his heirs, successors and assigns, does hereby further covenant and agree that when, in the judgment of the seller, the installation of sewers and sidewalks, and other public improvements become necessary, or advisable, the seller, at his option, shall have the right to install such system of sewers, sidewalks and other public improvements as in his judgment is necessary and advisable, and assess the just pro-rata cost against the lots benefited or affected thereby, and puchaser for himself, his heirs, successors, and assigns, covenants and agrees that upon the installation of such sewers, sidewalks and public improvements of either of them, he will thereupon pay his proportionate part of the costs of the same ascertained as aforesaid.
