

Assignment of Oil and Gas Lease No. 478

J. Green an undivided Three-fourths $\frac{3}{4}$ interest

of their right, title and interest of the original lessee and present owner ship in and to the said lease and rights thereunder in so far as it covers the Southwest Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) of the (Southeast) ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) Quarter of Section (23) Township (18), Range (14) East

together with all personal property used or obtained in connection therewith to

Thos. J. Green

And for the same consideration, the undersigned for themselves and their heirs, successors and assigns, do covenant with the said assignee, his heirs, successors or assigns, that they are the lawful owner of the said lease and rights and interests thereunder and of the personal property thereon or used in connection therewith; that the undersigned have good right and authority to sell and convey the same, and that said rights, interest and property are free and clear from all liens and incumbrances, and that all rentals and royalties due and payable thereunder have been duly paid.
