

No. 261588 C.J. Assignment of Oil and Gas Lease No. 478

WHEREAS, On the 7th day of January 1924, a certain oil and gas mining lease was made and entered into by and between Mary A. Russell and J. W. Russell, her husband, Gotham Oil & Gas Company, V. H. McNutt and Isabel D. St. Germain, Lessor, and R. J. St. Germain, Lessee,

NOW, THEREFORE, For and in consideration of One Dollar (and other good and valuable considerations), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned, the present owner, of the said lease and all rights thereunder or incident thereto, do hereby bargain, sell, transfer, assign and convey unto J. C. Leaw and Ray S. Fellows, each an undivided one-third (1/3)

of the right, title and interest of the original lessee and present owner in and to the said lease and rights thereunder in so far as it covers the NW/4 of SE/4 of Sec. 26, Township 19, North, Range 11 East; and an undivided 1/64 interest each of the right, title and interest of the original lessees in and to the said lease and rights thereunder, in so far as it covers the NE/4 of SE/4 of Sec. 26, Township 19 North, Range 11 East. J. C. Leaw and Ray S. Fellows together with all personal property used or obtained in connection therewith to.

And for the same consideration, the undersigned for himself and his heirs, successors and representatives, do hereby covenant with the said assignee, their heirs, successors or assigns, that he is the lawful owner of the said lease and rights and interests thereunder and of the personal property thereon or used in connection therewith; that the undersigned has good right and authority to sell and convey the same, and that said rights, interest and property are free and clear from all liens and incumbrances, and that all rentals and royalties due and payable thereunder have been duly paid.
