

## Assignment of Oil and Gas Lease No. 478

The undersigned make this assignment share and share alike out of their respective interests in said lease and each retains an undivided one-fourth interest therein

together with all personal property used or obtained in connection therewith to

Henry Oil Company

And for the same consideration, the undersigned for themselves and their heirs, successors and assigns, do covenant with the said assignee, its successors or assigns, that they are the lawful owner S of the said lease and rights and interests thereunder and of the personal property thereon or used in connection therewith; that the undersigned have good right and authority to sell and convey the same, and that said rights, interest and property are free and clear from all liens and incumbrances, and that all rentals and royalties due and payable thereunder have been duly paid.
