

## Assignment of Oil and Gas Lease No. 478

of the right, title and interest of the original lessee and present owner in and to the said lease and rights thereunder in so far as it covers the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 26, Township 19 North, Range 11 East, the ownership of said lease covering said 40 acre tract hereby becoming vested as follow: Superior Oil Corporation a one-half, R. J. St. Germain one-sixth, J. C. Leaw one-sixth and Ray S. Fellows one-sixth together with all personal property used or obtained in connection therewith to.
