Assignment of Oil and Gas Lease No. 478

WHEREAS, The said lease and all rights thereunder or incident thereto are now owned by Atlantic Petroleum Corporation and L.D. Ladd, the legal title to said lease being in Atlantic Petroleum Corporation and the said L.D. Ladd having the equitable title to an undivided 1/8th interest in said lease and the Atlantic Petroleum Corporation being the owner of the remaining interest in said lease.

NOW, THEREFORE, For and in consideration of One Dollar (and other good and valuable considerations), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned, the present owner, of the said lease and all rights thereunder or incident thereto, do hereby bargain, sell, transfer, assign and convey unto F. F. Black, Tulsa, Oklahoma, (it being hereby stipulated that the full consideration for this assignment is Two Thousand Two Hundred Eighty (\$2,280.00) Dollars)

all the right, title and interest of the original lessee and present owner, in and to the said lease and rights thereunder in so far as it covers the eighty acres above described

together with all personal property used or obtained in connection therewith to

F. F. Black, of Tulsa, Oklahoma.

And for the same consideration, the undersigned for themselves and their heirs, successors and assigns, do covenant with the said assignee, his heirs, successors or assigns, that they are the lawful owner of the said lease and rights and interests thereunder and of the personal property thereon or used in connection therewith; that the undersigned have good right and authority to sell and convey the same, and that said rights, interest and property are free and clear from all liens and incumbrances, and that all rentals and royalties due and payable thereunder have been duly paid.
