The H. P. Taubman Supply Co., Tulsa, Oklahoma, an undivided three-thirty-seconds (3/32nds)

of all his right, title and interest of the original lessee and present owner in and to the said lease and rights thereunder in so far as it covers the the above described land, said interest being a fractional part of the whole and not a fractional part of the whole less a one-eighth royalty, (that is to say: Not a fractional part of the net seven-eighths)

together with all personal property used or obtained in connection therewith to

H. P. Taubman Supply Co.

And for the same consideration, the undersigned for himself and his heirs, successors and assigns, that the undersigned, the lawful owner of the said lease and rights and interests thereunder and of the personal property thereon or used in connection therewith; that the undersigned, good right and authority to sell and convey the same, and that said rights, interest and property are free and clear from all liens and incumbrances, and that all rentals and royalties due and payable thereunder have been duly paid.
