This agreement made and entered into on this 21st day of December, 1917, by and between R. W. Smith, party of the first part, and Robert Shipman, party of the second part;

WITNESSETH: That under a contract made and entered into between the parties for this contract and one Mrs. Agnes Campbell of West Tulsa, upon Lots Fifteen (15), Sixteen (16), Seventeen (17) and Eighteen (18) in Block Nineteen (19) in West Tulsa Addition to the City of Tulsa, County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, whereby the parties to this contract paid to the said Agnes Campbell the sum of One Thousand dollars (\$1000.00) on the purchase price under the aforesaid contract with Agnes Campbell, said contract being dated the 29th day of March, 1917, and recorded with the Recorder of Deeds of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, on the 15th day of April, 1917.
