QUIT CLAIM DEED.COMPARED

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 24th day of September 1923 by and between Rube Harris and Bessie L. Harris parties of the first part, and Violet S. Gamble nee Harris party of the second part,

WITNESSETH That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar and other valuable considerations (1.00) Dollars, to us duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged we remised, released, and quitclaimed, by these presents do for themselves their heirs, executors and administrators, remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, and to her heirs and assigns, forever, all their right, title, interest, estate, claim and demand both at law and in equity, of, in and to all the following described land situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) and all of Lot Five (5)

And North one half (N $\frac{1}{2}$) of Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$)

And North 15.31 acres of lot six (6) in Section fourteen (14)

And Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirteen (13) all in Township Twenty (20) North, Range Twelve (12) east, and containing 114.93 acres, more or less.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining to the above described premises forever, unto the said Violet S.
