WHEREAS, L. V. Burwell, on the 19th day of November A.D.1923, produced to the under-  
signed W. W. Stuckey County Treasurer of the County of Tulsa in the State of Oklahoma, a  
certificate or purchase in writing, bearing the date of the 1st day of November A.D.1920,  
signed by W. W. Stuckey who at the last-named date was Treasurer of said County, from which  
it appears that W. W. Stuckey as such County Treasurer of Tulsa County, of Oklahoma, did  
on the 1st day of November A.D.1920, by virtue of authority in him vested by law, at (an  
adjourned sale) a sale of delinquent lands, begun and publicly held on the first Monday  
in November, 1920, between the hours of nine o'clock A.M. and four o'clock P.M. of said day  
(and adjourned from day to day thereafter, between the same hours) offer at public sale,
