ORDER DIRECTING CONVEYANCE.

This cause coming on to be heard this 5th day of December, 1923, the petition of
 EXCHANGE TRUST COMPANY, Executor of the Last Will and Testament of George C. Gray, deceased,
 praying an order of this Court authorizing and directing it to execute and deliver to
 M. Gray its deed of conveyance of certain real estate belonging to said estate, and the Court
 being fully advised in the premises, finds:

That under the terms and provisions of the Last Will and Testament of George C. Gray,
 deceased, the following described property is in the county of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma,
 as given and devised to Harold M. Gray, son of decedent, under certain conditions:

Lot Fourteen (14) in Block Nineteen (19) of Cherokee Heights Addition
 the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat therefor.

That the portion of said will relating to said property, and the disposition thereof, is as
 follows:

"Fourth. I hereby state that I am the owner of Lot Fourteen (14) in Block Nineteen (19)
 of Cherokee Heights Addition to the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma, which said lot
 hereinbefore devised and given to my son, Harold M. Gray, and I have given unto
 my said son the option to purchase said Lot Fourteen (14) in Block Nineteen (19)
 of said addition, within one year from the date of my death for the sum of Two
 Thousand dollars (\$2000.00) and the purchase price paid therefor shall become a
 part of my estate and shall be disposed of as hereinafter directed. I intend, however,
 that in case my said son shall not desire to purchase said lot within
 said time, then such option shall cease and said property shall become a part of
 the rest, residue and remainder of my estate and shall be disposed of as hereinafter
 directed."

That said George C. Gray died on the 17th day of November, 1922 and the said Harold M.
 Gray, on the 1st day of November, 1923, less than one year after the death of said George
 C. Gray, exercised his right of option in said matter, and paid said Two Thousand (\$2,000.00)
 to said Executor and agreed to take said lot under the terms and provisions of said will as
 above set forth, and has requested that Executor deliver to him its deed therefor.

That all of the terms and provisions of said will relating to the disposition of
 said lot have been complied with on the part of said Harold M. Gray, and he is entitled to
 a deed of conveyance therefor.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that said EXCHANGE TRUST
 COMPANY, as Executor of the Last Will and Testament of George C. Gray, deceased, be, and it
 is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver its deed conveying to said Harold
 M. Gray the real estate hereinbefore described.
