

upon which said City of Tulsa, may allow public service corporations, companies, individuals or itself to construct, maintain and operate facilities for public utilities, including poles, wires, pipes, conduits and other necessary accessories; and,

Provided, further, that four (4) feet on each side of the center line of said alley shall be construed to mean sufficient space near the center of said alley for the purposes above specified, and provided further, that the above vacation is made subject to the conditions and provisions of Paragraph II of Section 6, of Article 11 of the Charter of the City of Tulsa.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance insofar as such conflict exists, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. That an emergency exists for the preservation of the public welfare and safety, by reason whereof, this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.

PASSED, and the emergency clause ruled upon separately and approved this 16th day of November, 1923.

SEWER BASEMENT.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the undersigned, the owner of the legal and equitable title to the following described real estate, situated in the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) cash in hand, paid by the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and other good and valuable considerations, receipt of which are hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant and convey unto the said City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, a perpetual easement, through, over, under and across the following described property, situated in said City, to-wit:

A strip of ground, not to exceed ten (10) feet in width on either side of the center line of said sewer line, as shown by the blue prints on file in the City Engineer's office of the City of Tulsa, the center line of said Twenty (20) foot strip being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

South ten (10) feet of Lot 17, Block 7, Terwilliger Heights, an addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the duly recorded plat thereof, for the purpose of permitting the City of Tulsa to construct a sewer line thereto, through, over, under and across said property, together with all necessary and convenient appurtenances thereto; and to use and maintain the same, and of affording the City of Tulsa, its officers,
