Decree of Distribution and Final Discharge of Administrator.

Now on this 20th day of October, 1923, this matter coming on to be heard upon the final report of the administrator, M. W. Smith.

And there appearing herein, the Administrator, M. W. Smith, and his attorney of record, Ralsa F. Morley, and there also appearing Florence J. and Annie L. Smith, daughters of Robert L. Smith, deceased; and John Marshall and Robert L. Smith, sons of Robert L. Smith, deceased; and it having been shown to the court that the Administrator, M. W. Smith, filed herein his final report on the 23 day of September, 1923, and that the clerk of said court appointed the 20th day of October for the hearing thereof; and it having been shown that due and legal notice of the time and place of the said hearing has been given as required by law and by the order of this court; and said final report having been examined by this court and all matters therein having been approved; and no persons appearing to contest or object to the same, and it having been shown to the court that there is a balance of 258.37, Dollars on hand due to the heirs at law of the said Robert L. Smith, deceased, after the payment of all debts and an attorney's fee to the attorney of record, Ralsa F. Morley in the sum of 100.00 Dollars; and after hearing all the evidence and being satisfied that all taxes upon the property of the estate and all inheritance taxes which have become due and payable, have been fully paid, the court orders distribution of said estate as follows:

It is therefore, Ordered, Adjudged and Decreed by the Court that said deceased died intestate and leaving no will and that he left surviving as his only heirs at law those certain persons whose names and relationship to said deceased were as follows, to-wit:

Florence J. Smith, daughter, residence near Owasso, Oklahoma,

Robert L. Smith, son, residence near Owasso, Oklahoma,

John Marshall Smith, son, residence near Owasso, Oklahoma, Annie L. Smith, daughter, residence near Owasso, Oklahoma.

who are the sole and only heirs of the said Robert L. Smith, deceased.

The Court further finds that the residue of the estate of said deceased as hereinafter decreed and all other property of said estate, whether described herein or not, be distributed according to law as follows:

To the said Florence J. Smith, daughter, an undivided one-fourth ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the entire estate, both real estate, personal or mixed;

To John M. Smith, son, and undivided one-fourth ($\frac{1}{4}$) interest of the entire estate, both real estate, personal or mixed;

To Robert L. Smith, son, an undivided one-fourth ($\frac{1}{4}$) interest in the entire estate, both real estate, personal or mixed;

To Annie L. Smith, daughter, an undivided one-fourth ($\frac{1}{4}$) interest of the entire estate, both real estate, personal or mixed;

the aforesaid four children being the sole and only heirs of the said Robert L. Smith, who inherit all of his estate.

The general character and known real estate which is to be divided as aforesaid between the aforesaid heirs is as follows, to-wit:

An undivided one-half interest in East One-Half ($E\frac{1}{2}$) of the South-west Quarter, ($SW\frac{1}{4}$), and the South-east Quarter, ($SE\frac{1}{4}$), and the North-east
