UIL AND GAS LEASE

COMPARED

WHEREAS, Jacob Bittle and Aramindia Bittle are the owners, in fee simple, of the East half (E2) of the Northeast quarter (NE2) of Section 13, Township 16 North, Range 12 East, Tulse County, Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Eastern Oil Company, and the States retroleum Company, own and operate an Oil and Gas Mining lease on the above described land; and

WHEREAS; the said oil and gas mining lease recorded in Book 99, at page 28, with the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, makes no direct provision for the royalty for gas sold from wells producing oil on the said lease; and

whereas, the lessors and Lessees are desirous of making and entering into an agreement and fixing certain, the amount to be paid as royalty for oil wells which produce gas.

NOW. THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar paid to Lessor by Lessees, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and for other good and valuable considerations, itis mutually agreed that the royalty for gas from wells which produce oil, is and shall be from and after this date, as follows:

> "The lessees agree to pay the lessors for gas from oil wells, sold off the premises a royalty one one-eighth part of the net proceeds received by them for the said gas, said payments to be figured and paid monthly."

It is further mutually understood and agreed that all other provisions of the said oil and gas mining lease be and they shall remain the same as are now provided in said oil and gas mining lease.
