MORTGAGE OF OIL & GAS LEASES.

COMPARED

THIS AGREEMENT MADE AND ENTERED into on this 20th day of September, 1923, by and between The Lincoln Company, a Corporation, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, party of the first part and The Liberty National Bank, a banking corporation of Tulsa, Oklahoma, party of the second part;

WITNESSETH:

THAT WHEREAS, the party of the first part is the owner of an undivided thirteen-forty-eighths (13/48) interest in and to the oil and gas mining lease described as follows;

E $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 17, Township 18 North, Range 13 East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

NOW, THEREFORE, as security for the payment of four promissory notes described below, the party of the first part does by these presents mortgage and convey unto the second party its successors and assigns, all its interest in the sforesaid oil and gas mining lease and all its interest in all of the oil or gas wells thereon and in the machinery, pipes, derricks, tubing and all other oil well supplies or machinery located on or used in connectinn therewith in which the first party might be interested, said notes described as follows:

One note in the principal sum of \$20,000.00, dated August 27th, 1923, due 90 days from date, bearing interest from date at the rate of 6%, signed by The Lincoln Company,

One note in the principal sum of \$2,000.00, dated September 10th, 1923, due 90 days from date, bearing interest from date at the rate of 6% signed by The Lincoln Company,
