THE MUSKOGEE ( CREEK) NATION,  
STATE OF OKLAHOMA,  
( FORMERLY INDIAN TERRITORY)

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS, The land hereinafter described is a portion of the unallotted lands of the Muskogee (Creek) Tribe of Indians and the same has been sold to Joseph L. Hutchings for the sum of Twenty-two and 50/100 Dollars (\$22.50) in accordance with the regulations prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior, October 12, 1910, under the provisions of Section sixteen of the Act of Congress approved April 26, 1906, (34 Stat. L., 137).

NOW, THEREFORE, I, the undersigned, the Principal Chief of the Muskogee (Creek) Nation, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by law, have granted and conveyed, and by these presents do grant and convey unto the said Joseph L. Hutchings all right, title and interest of the Muskogee (Creek) Nation and of all of the citizens thereof in and to the following described land, viz: The South East Quarter of the South east Quarter of the South East quarter of the North West Quarter of Section Thirty (30), Township Nineteen (19) North and Range Ten (10) East of the Indian Meridian, in Oklahoma, containing Two and 50/100 (2.50) acres, more or less, as the case may be, according to the United States survey thereof.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, the Principal Chief of the Muskogee (Creek) Nation, have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of said Nation to be affixed this 15th day of January, A. D., 1913.
