and any amount so collected by such Receiver shall be applied, under direction of the Court, to the payment of any judgment rendered, or amount found due upon foreclosure of this mortgage, and in the event action is brought to foreclose this mortgage, a reasonable attorney fees of not less than an amount equal to ten per cent of the principal note or notes herein described shall be added, and in no event less than the sum of Fifty Dollars, which this mortgage also secures.
