Whereas, Emma Liver, now Glass a citizen of the Cherokee Nation, was allotted the following described land, to-wit:

West Half ( W2) of Southwest quarter (SW4) of Section  
Twelve (12), Township Twenty (20) North, Range Thirteen (13) East of the  
Indian Base and Meridian containing 80 acres, more or less, located in Tulsa  
County, Oklahoma,

Now, Therefore, I, under the authority vested in me by the Act of Congress approved May 27, 1908, (Public No. 140,) and the regulations prescribed thereunder, hereby remove the restrictions from said described land, such removal of restrictions to become effective only and simultaneously with the execution of the deed by said allottee to the purchaser after said land has been sold in compliance with the directions of the Secretary of the Interior.
