AGREEMENT

COMPARED

THIS AGREEMENT, Made and entered into this 8th day of December 1923, by and between E. M. Arnold, of Tulsa, Okla., party of the first part, and GYPSY OIL COMPANY, a corporation, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, party of the second part, does

WITNESS

That,

FOR and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration this day in hand paid by the party of the second part to the party of the first part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has bargained, sold, transferred, assigned and delivered, and by these presents does bargain, sell, transfer, assign and deliver unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, all of his right, title, interest and estate in and to an oil and gas mining lease and the leasehold estate thereby created, in so far as it covers the following described land situate in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

The West half of the Southwest Quarter (W $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) and the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 8, Township 18 North, Range 13 East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, containing 120 acres;

which said leasehold estate is evidenced by an oil and gas mining lease covering the above described premises dated the 25th day of March, 1910, and made between Henry W. Perryman as lessor, and E. M.
