WARRANTY DEED.

AUTOMAL PERSONAL

The State of Oklahoma SSS County of Tulsa) Know all men by these presents: That I, John J. Harden, of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred Fifty and no.100 (\$750.00) dollars, to me in hand paid by A. W. Hamill, the receipt of which is hereby fully acknowledged.

Have granted, sold and conveyed, and by these presents, do grant, sell, and convey unto the said A. W. Hamill, of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoga, all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land lying and being situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and being lot #135 in Rose Lawn section, containing 500 square feet, be the same more or less out of Rose Hill Burial Park as fully appears from map of said Burial Park hereby referred to and made a part hereof.

It is understood and agreed that should A. W. Hamill, or his legal heirs, later desire space in a Community Mausoleum, should same be erected in Rose Hill Burlal Park, or desire exchange the described lot for location elsewhere, of equal or greater value, in Rose Hill Burlal Park, a crait will be given for current saleable value of above described lot.

It is expressly agreed and understood that this conveyance is made subject to the provisions and restrictions specified in the rules and regulations of said Burial Park at the present time, and which are made a part of this conveyance, or which said Burial Park may hereafter make in conformity with the laws of the State of Oklahoma.

The said Grantor hereby covements and agrees with the said grantee to setaside ten per cent of the consideration of this deed forever hereafter from the income of said sum, and from the income of other funds created from a definite part of the proceeds of lot sales, from time to time, apply the income from said amounts for the perpetaul care and maintenance of said Rose Hill Burgial Park.
