RELEASE OF MORTGAGE.

Whereas, on the 3rd day of July, 1918, David H. Curran and Ada C. Curran, husband and wife, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, made, executed and delivered to the Commissioners of the Land Office of the State of Oklahoma, for the use and benefit of the State of Oklahoma, one certain note for the sum of : Twenty five hundred and no/100 (\$2500.00) dollars secured by a real estate mortgage on all of the following described real property situated in Tulsa County, to-wit:

South half of northwest quarter of sec. 8, twp. 18 north range 13 E, I B & M, less 1 1/2 acres thereof described as follows, Beginning at the northwest corner of the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section 8, twp. 18 north, range 13 east, and running thence fifteen rods south along the section line between sections 7, 8 thence east sixteen rods, thence north fifteen rods, thence west sixteen rods to place of beginning.

This mortgage being recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, on the 8th day of July, 1919, at 3 o'clock P.M. in book 242, page 341, of mortgages.

Whereas, at the regular meeting of the Commissioners of the Land Office of the State of Oklahoma, held June 17th, 1913, the following resolution was adopted:

"Be it resolved, that the Secretary to the Commissioners of the Land office of the State of Oklahoma, be and he is hereby authorized to accept payment of any mortgage and the debt secured thereby made to the Commissioner of the Land office of the State of Oklahoma, and upon such payment having been made, the Chairman and the Secretary to the Commissioners of the Land office of the State of Oklahoma, on behalf of the Commissioners be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to execute good and sufficient release to the proper parties therefore!"

All vote "aye". Motion prevailed.

Whereas, payment in full having been made on said note.

Now, therefore, under and by virtue of the above resolution, the Commissioners of the Land Office by their Chairman and Secretary for and on behalf of the State of Oklahoma, in consideration of value received, do hereby acknowledge full payment and complete satisfaction of the mortgage above described, and do hereby release and discharge said land from the lien of said mortgage.
