
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GENERAL WARRARY DEED.



This indenture, made this 18th day of December, A.D. 1923, between Terrace Drive Company, a corporation, organized under the laws of the State of Oklahoma, of Tulas, County of Tulas, State of Chahoma, party of the first part, and J. A. Cunning ham, and H. G. Obermiller, party of the second part.

Witnesseth, that in consideration of the sum of one dollar and other good and valuable considerations, dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, said party of the first part, does, by these presents, grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto said party of the second part, their heirs, executors or administrators; all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot sixteen (16) in block twom(2) of the subdivision of blocks two (2) three (3) and seven (7) in Terrace Drive addition to the City of Talsa County of Talsa, State, of Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof.

To have sad to hold the same, together with all and singler the tenementsm hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appartaining forever.

And said Terrace Drive Company, a corporation, its successors or amigns does hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part at the deliveryrof these presents that it is lawfully saized in its own right of an absolute and indefensible estate of inheritance in fee simple, of and in all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances that the same are free, clear and discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates, judgements, taxes, assessments and incumbrances of whatsoever nature and kind, except, general and special taxes for the year, 1919, and subsequent years, and it is further agreed between the parties hereto that this lot is sold for residence purcess only and no dwelling shall be erected thereon to cost less than three thomand dollars no part of which shall be nearer the front lot line than twenty feet, and that said Corporation will warent and forever defend the same unto said party of the second part their heirs, executors or administrators, against said party of the first part, their sudgessors messigns, and all and every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim thesame.
