a citizen of the Cherokee Nation, was allotted the following described land, to-wit:

West half (W $\frac{1}{2}$) of southeast quarter (SE4) of southeast
 quarter (SE $\frac{1}{2}$) south^{east} quarter (SE4) of southeast quarter (SE4)
 of section eighteen (18) township twenty (20) north range fourteen
 (14) east of the Indian Base and Meridian, containing thirty (30)
 acres, more or less located in Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

Now, therefore, I, under the authority vested in me by the Act of Congress approved May
 27, 1908 (public No. 140) and the regulations prescribed thereunder, hereby remove the
 restrictions from said described land, such removal of restrictions to become effective
 only and simultaneously with the execution of the deed by said allottee to the purchaser
 after said land has been sold in compliance with the directions of the Secretary of the Interior.

 dollars (\$960.00) in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto Perry W. Sharp, Tulsa, Oklahoma, part of the second part, the
 following described real property and premises, situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

West half (W $\frac{1}{2}$) of southeast quarter (SE4) of south east quarter (SE4) and
 southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of southwest quarter (SW4) of southeast
 quarter (SE4) of section eighteen (18) township twenty (20) north,
 range fourteen (14) east of the Indian Base and Meridian, con-
 taining thirty (30) acres, more or less, located in Tulsa County,
 Oklahoma.
