This cause coming to be heard before the court on this 13th day of December, 1923, the same being one of the regular judicial days of the November, 1923, term of said court upon the report of the commissioners, J. S. Shaver, J. O. Campbell and Ira E. Brooks, heretofore filed herein on the 12th day of December, 1923 and upon the petition of the respective attorneys for allowance of attorneys' fees therein, and taxing of costs the plaintiff being present in person and by her attorneys, Boone & Mason, and the defendants being present by their guardian-ad-litem, M. C. Spredling, and it appearing to the court that there have been no objections filed to the report of said commissioners, and all parties being now present and before the court, and after due consideration of said report by the court and the court being well and sufficiently advised of its opinion.

It is/hereby ordered, adjudged and decreed that the report of the Commissioners, J.S. Shaver, J. O. Campbell, and Ira E. Brooks, filed herein on December 12, 1923, awarding and partitioning to Sallie Taylor Schooley the following described real estate and premises situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

Let 1, in Block 89 of the original townsite of Tulsa, be and the same is hereby ratified, approved and confirmed, and said real estate and premises as described be and the same is hereby awarded and partitioned to Sallie Taylor Schooley, the plaintiff herein as her 5/9 interest in the property described in her petition and sought to be partitioned herein; and the report of said commissioners so filed awarding and partitioning to Howard Arthur Taylor and Jack Morgan Taylor, jointly the following described real estate and premises situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

The north 45 feet of lot 6, and the south 15 feet
of lot 7, in block 3, north Tulsa addition to
the City of Tulsa,

and

Lot 1, in block 19, Lynch-Forsythe addition
to the City of Tulsa,

and

Lot 1, in Block 3, Locust Grove addition
to the city of Tulsa.
